Never has man been at liberty to pick and choose which commands to obey. (1 Sam. 15:22).

Jesus defines for us exactly what a **true** disciple is (*John 8:31*). When we learn a teaching of Christ or His apostles, we are obligated to do it. In our obedience we show Jesus our love for Him. It is always easy to do the things we want to, but to be
